

2019 LIMESTONE COMMUNITY HIGH SCHOOL LOCAL SCHOLARSHIP APPLICATION INSTRUCTIONS

- Over 30 local scholarships are available through this single application process. This is your opportunity to be acknowledged for your academic, co-curricular and community service achievements throughout your high school career.
- Scholarship awards administered by the Limestone Scholarship Committee are intended for spring 2019 graduates of LCHS who will be full-time students in the 2019 fall semester as defined by the college or university of attendance. Part-time status may result in the forfeiture of the scholarship.
- You must go to the **Limestone webpage** (click on the “**Scholarship**” banner to get the documents needed to apply for the scholarships).
 - The application is a google document.
 - Click on the “Scholarship Application” link and sign into your LCHS Google Apps account (limestone310.org).
 - Once it has opened, go to File, make a Copy and rename the document as your Last Name, First Name application - ie “Wenzel, Katie application”.
 - Print your application once completed. Make sure all signatures are on the printed document.
 - Turn in completed application to Mrs. Wenzel by Wednesday, February 20th at or before 3:00 p.m.
- You need to complete every part of the application. You will be evaluated by the committee on all areas of the application, and if you leave areas blank, it will affect your overall score. The application is evaluated on many different areas including: school activities, leadership, community service/work experience, awards, academics, teacher references, and essay.
- A copy of your transcript, your ACT or SAT score, class rank and GPA will be included with your application. All information will be held in strict confidence.
- You **MUST** ask two teachers to write recommendations for you. They will fill out a Google form which will be sent directly to Mrs. Wenzel. Recommendations must come from a teacher you have had in class.
- Save your completed application on your Google drive once you are done. You may be asked for an electronic copy of your application for further review.
- The completed, printed application **MUST** be signed by the student and a parent/guardian.
- The essay prompt is “What have you learned during your experiences at Limestone that will **most** impact the next step in your life?”
 - The essay should be 300 – 400 words double-spaced (about 1 page).
 - The essay needs to be free of grammatical, punctuation and spelling errors.
 - You need to PROOFREAD your essay.
 - All the committee members will be reading and scoring your essay. For some committee members this essay will be the only impression he/she has of you. Make it a good impression.
 - Poor essays will result in lower scores.
- Be sure to print and fill out the additional applications for specific criteria scholarships for which you qualify.

 - Bryan Maser Memorial Scholarship
 - Limestone Girls Softball Association
- The completed application and teacher recommendations must be received by Mrs. Wenzel in the Guidance office by **3:00 pm Wednesday, February 20th.**
